A fully stocked bar offering beer and wine, plus banquet facilities and large outdoor patio overlooking the course. For tournaments and special events, outstanding food service is available, or you can cater it yourself. The beer and wine bar is available for all events including weddings, special occasions, corporate outings and social events.

Golf Shop: The golf pro shop is completely stocked with a wide variety of top of the line merchandise and equipment. You'll find every item the golfer will need to enjoy and improve the game. Private lessons are available by appointment.

Practice Area: Offers one of the best public practice facilities in Pima County. The facility includes practice putting greens, chipping green and driving range (over 300 yards) for all clubs.

Special Features: The 200-acre setting makes this golfing layout more interesting as you play and view the beautiful ironwoods, mesquites and saguaros. Situated in a rugged terrain with scenery surrounding the course and enhanced by the fact no homes are lining its fairways. You can enjoy the craggy beauty of the Sonoran Desert Southwest. There are stunning views of all five mountain ranges of the area (Catalina, Tucson, Tortolita, Rincon and Santa Rita) offering beautiful sunrises and sunsets with gorgeous vistas.

The three (3) water basins used for irrigation and aesthetics is also used to present water hazards that can come into play on five (5) of the 18 holes.

Noteworthy: Crooked Tree Golf Course has hosted the Tucson Tour Players Qualifying, the Southern Arizona Open with Tucson National and has hosted the Pima County Amateur Championship for over 20 years and was the Tucson Open's Qualifying course for twelve years.

First Tee: Crooked Tree proudly hosts the PGA's First Tee program. Summer junior clinics are held here allowing the youth to get a jumpstart on learning the game. The Tucson Conquistadors have chosen Crooked Tree as the new site for their First Tee program. The First Tee Golf Course will not only offer a beneficial service to the youth of the area but also gain a very popular 9-hole golf course attractions that in the future can be lighted along with the nearby driving range. These two new products together will not only generate positive awareness for the attraction but also introduce the facility to a younger and more active audience.
